

Getting started


Your Principal has to register your school first!


Sign in with the same username you use to access the Learning Place (MIS-ID)



3. Sample first

Some of the popular books can only be downloaded 20-30 times per year. This is a rule set by the publishing companies. So if you borrow just to look at the book (and never read it) then uses on of our "borrows" and we have to purchase the book again. Most of the collection is **unlimited** borrowing however some popular titles (e.g. the Hobbit and C2C titles) have limited downloads.

Please SAMPLE first. It's like browsing before you borrow in a library. If you really want to read the book then you can borrow it. If it's already borrowed, then you can add the eBook to your wish list. When it becomes available you will be notified when you next log in.







4. Borrow an eBook


When you borrow an eBook, you have it for 7 days. No one else can borrow it at the same time. If you decide you don't want to read it then please return it so someone else can read it. It's just like borrowing a book from the library.

You have two choices when you borrow a book:


- 1. Download it to your computer or device
